Plane vs. Train

The travel time by plane is the duration of the flight plus approximately three hours for the journey to and from the airport, and check-in and transfer times. In some cases, a train may be as quick or even quicker than going by plane.

Because the seats take up more floor space, flying business class creates roughly 3x as much CO₂e as flying economy class.

We **measure** our business travel emissions by plane and train, and record these in internal databases.

Any remaining emissions that we currently cannot reduce are **compensated** in collaboration with FairClimateFund.

We **aim** to reduce travel emissions by 65% (compared to a 2015 baseline) by 2030.

We **communicate** our progress to our internal and external stakeholders via our Plant Based Positive Impact report.
